Minor's Timeline & Check-off List

Learner's Permit

1. Driver's Education Classes.
 - a. You can be 14 years of age, at the minimum.
(NOTE: You cannot receive instruction permit until age 15½.)
2. Receive a Certificate of Completion (DL 400B) from the driver's education facility upon completing the required classes.
3. Permit Test at Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV)
 - a. What you need to bring...
 - i. Certificate of Completion Drivers Education (DL 400B).
 - ii. \$31 fee.
 - iv. Certified birth certificate (Check California Handbook for other approved documents)
 - v. Social Security card.
 - vi. DMV Application (DL 44) completed with parents'/guardian's signature.

6. Call Code 3 Driving School, Inc. (559) 297-6903.
 - a. Schedule your first driver's training session.
 - b. You need a minimum of 3 days of 2-hour sessions. Please leave time (1 month) before your drive test appointment to complete the drivers' training program.
7. Receive a Certificate of Completion of Drivers Training (gold) (OL 238) (all balances must be paid in full by last lesson) from the driver's training instructor upon completing the required lessons.

Driver's License

8. MUST BRING A LICENSED DRIVER TO TRANSPORT YOU TO THE DMV
 - a. Valid permit, signed by parent/guardian.
 - i. Must have had in your possession for a minimum of 6 months from the date you passed the permit test.
 - ii. Minimum of 50 hours total, 10 hours at night with parent or guardian (no documentation needed).
 - b. Proof of current insurance for car used in driving test
 - c. Proof of current registration for car used in driving test
 - d. Drivers Training Certificate of Completion (gold) (OL 238)
